**Reviewing the Research and Charting a Path Forward**

**As the population of schoolchildren in the U.S. becomes increasingly more diverse, public and independent Montessori schools alike are serving an ever-more racially and culturally diverse group of students. In fact, students of color comprise over half of public Montessori school enrollment. In the context of urgent and ongoing public conversations about promoting equity through education, where does Montessori stand? In this presentation, Dr. Katie Brown will review the research on outcomes and experiences for students of color in Montessori schools. This research highlights both opportunities and limitations for students of color, with implications for Montessori teacher training, family engagement, and classroom practice.**
