Eligibility Requirements:

- 1. Be a resident of the Nauck Community and a graduate of Arlington County Public High School, and has been accepted as a full time student (12 semester credit hours or more) in an accredited two or four year college, university, technical or higher education institution recognized by the U.S. Department of Education.
- 2. Possess at least a 2.5 cumulative GPA on a 4.0 scale
- 3. Demonstrated community services implemented while serving in leadership position.
- 4. Provide two letters of recommendation from a teacher, counselor or community leader.
- 5. Draft a 250 word essay on "What Have I Done for My Community". Plus completion of questions on attached application.

*Note scholarship will be paid upon providing proof of enrollment.

All applications received will be reviewed by the *Nauck Civic Association Executive Board Committee*. The deadline for submitting your application must be post marked no later than July 31st. The scholarship winner will be notified prior to and announced at the Nauck Civic and Community Pride Day, which is held the third Saturday in September at Drew Model School & Community Center. The scholarship award of \$500.00 will be presented to the scholarship recipient (proof of enrollment required prior to award).
